

Bath Salt Carrots



Used Materials:

Soap colouring, 10 ml orange	497160	1

Soap scent oil , Made from plant material, Jasmin	466185	1

Felt wool band, light green	566210	1
Felt string, 5 m light green	536622	1

Recommended Materials:

Soap scent oil, made from natural materials, lilac	466200	1
Soap oil, 10 ml vanilla	497230	1
Soap oil, 10 ml Cherry blossom	481204	1
One way protective gloves	936396	1

Required Material: plastic bag for mixing



Instructions

1: First cut 3 approx. 7 – 10cm long pieces from the felt string. Then cut one end to create stripes looking like carrot herb. Fill the desired quantity of bath salt in a large plastic bag. Add a few drops of orange soap colour and 2 – 3 drops of yellow soap colour.

Keep the bag close and shake it well. If you don't like the incurred colour you will add more colour drops. Now take a flat bag and cut it by the closed side diagonally upward, so that a carrot shape arise.

Close the open lengthwise side of the bag with tape.

2: Furthermore fill the bath salt in the plastic shape (spare 3cm to the edge). Take the cutted felt stripes and add it to the bag. Finally close the carrot bag with the felt string.
