

Wooden sphere, approx. ø 30 mm, drill hole: ca. 6 mm, set of 6	601941	2

Gas lighter (to seal the ends of the PARACORD threads)





Cut the two boards to a length of approx. 40 and 50 cm.



Drill 6 mm holes approx. 2 x 2 cm away from the outside edges.



Shorten the PARACORD to $2 \times 1,40 \text{m} - 2 \times 1 \text{m}$. Thread the long cord through the large board and the short cord through the short board. Fix the wooden spheres with a know at the bottom and fuse the ends with the lighter.

Hint: Shorten the dowel to approx. 50 cm and a piece of PARACORD to approx. 1,50 m. Tie a loop at both ends of the cord to place the dowel inside. Add the PARACORD with the boards first.
