Tools needed

Protective cover, scissors, washing up liquid, mixing beaker, measuring jug, spatula, paint brushes, glue

Instructions:

- 1. Rinse the mould well with water and washing up liquid. This will help to remove the casts easily later on.
- 2. Mix the casting compound using 1 part water with 2.5 parts casting compound.
- 3. Pour the mixture into the mould.
- 4. When the compound sets, it creates heat. As long as the mould still feels warm, the cast model should not be taken out.
- 5. Remove carefully after 30-40 minutes.
- 6. Let the cast dry again once it has been taken out of the mould and before painting it.
- 7. Paint the casts and the spatulas with acrylic paint and let the paint dry.
- 8. Draw designs on the casts and spatulas with the PlusterPens. Let the paint dry.
- 9. Affix the cast to a spatula (either with glue gun or craft glue).
