Tools Required		
Working pad, scissors, kitchen roll, round and bristle brush, measuring cup (or scales), mixing bowl, whisk (or spatula), hot glue gun with glue sticks		



- 1. Generously apply Formestone to the interior surface of the casting mould (according to product instruction) and allow to dry.
- 2. Insert the dowels several times into Formalate casting compound (according to product instruction), allow to dry.
- 3. Glue dowels as place holders (for cord and bow) to the interior surfaces of the casting mould (glue gun).
- 4. Mix fine concrete according to product instruction.
- 5. Completely fill up the casting mould.
- 6. Allow to harden for 1 2 days.
- 7. Remove place holders for bow/cord (dowels).
- 8. Remove cast concrete stars from the mould.
- 9. Allow residual moisture to escape from the concrete.
- 10. Apply paint with dabbers or brush and allow to dry.
- 11. Cut ribbon and cord to desired size.
- 12. Lead ribbon or cord through the hole of the concrete pendant.
- 13. Close with bow or knot.
