support, ruler, casting mould holder, cardboard or bucket (for hang up the latex casting mould), adhesive tape, scissors, kitchen roll, measuring cup (or scales), mixing bowl, egg whip (or spatula), disposable protective gloves, bristle brush, spatula for colour, water container, knife, hot glue gun (with glue sticks), sand		

## **Instruction**

0. Coat the inside of the latex moulds with release agent Formestone (follow product instructions).

1. Let release agent Formestone dry.

2. Mix creative concrete with water according to product insructions.





3. Hang the latex mould into a bucket/ box using the mould holder.

- 4. The latex mould should hang without hitting.
- 5. Fill the latex mould with concrete.
- 6. Let Creative Concrete dry overnight.
- 7. Remove the concrete pine out of the latex mould.
- 8. Let residual moisture escape from the concrete.
- 9. Paint concrete pine cones.



The instructions are transferable to the illustrated concrete pine cones.

10. Prime clay pots light blue.

11. Apply the colours antique blue, antique pink, coffee cream on a spatula.

12. Strip off the spatula on the clay pot (= spatula technique).

13. Repeat this process several times until the desired stripe effect is achieved.

- 14. Allow paint application to dry.
- 15. Paint wicker wreaths with the paint antique blue (brush).
- 16. Allow paint application to dry.

17. Measure the inside of the clay pot, cut the flower foam into this size.

18. Fix the flower foam with the hot glue gun inside the pot.

19. Flower foam should not protrude over the pot.

20. Attach the (large) wicker wreath at the flower foam.

(hot glue gun).

21. Fix the pine cone inside the wicker wreath.

22. Cover the gap between the concrete pine cone and the wicker wreath with Iceland moss (hot glue gun).

Tip:

If you would like to place the smaller pine cone (Art. No. 810618) in a clay pot, do not pour the pine base. The pine cone without a base is easier to fix in the pot!
