Hearts

support, base, scissors, knife, pruning shears, small branches, drill with wood drill (size in branch diameters), hot glue gun (with glue sticks), all purpose glue		

- 1. Stick the wooden heart with wooden discs or fragments of wood (craft glue or hot glue gun).
- 2. Allow to dry.
- 3. Using the drill to drill a hole in branch thickness into the upper side of the birch stems.
- 4. Fix the branch to the back of the decorated wooden heart.
- 5. Insert and glue branch into the hole of birch stem.
- 6. Tie a bow of vichy-tape below the heart.
- 7. Decorate branch with jute yarn.

- 1. Drill two holes, at the edge below the upper edge of the plywood board (approx. \emptyset 3,5 mm).
- 2. Pull a piece of jute through these holes so that the board can be hung up later.
- 3. If you want to hang a pen at the board, fix a piece of jute yarn in the desired length. Attach the pen later.
- 4. Glue the wood pieces to the plywood board by using craft glue or the hot glue gun.
- 5. After drying, attach the clothes pegs to the wood pieces.
- 6. Allow to dry.
- 7. Knot the pen to the provided jute yarn.
