

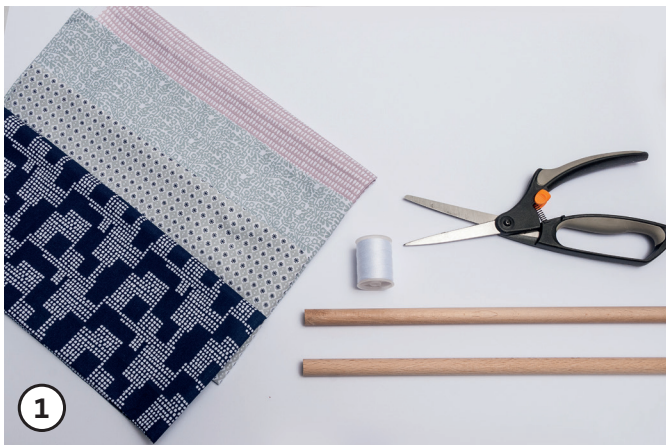

Ideas made of Fabric

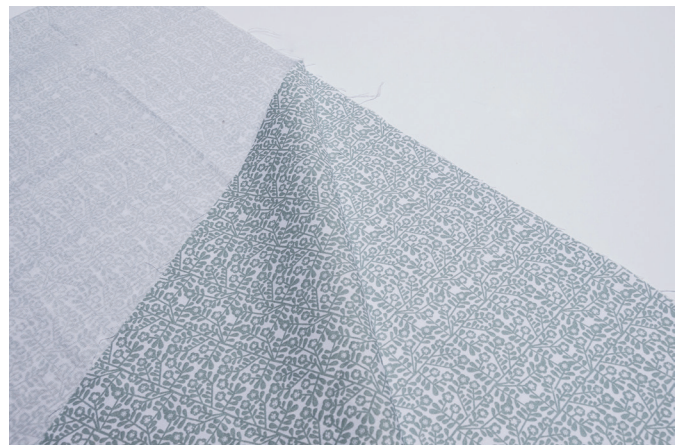
Tools



Material Used	Article Number	Quantity
Cotton fabric - flower print, about 1.40 m long, about 50 cm wide	958613	1
Cotton fabric droplet print, about 1.40 m long, about 50 cm wide	958635	1
Cotton fabric - Graphic print, approx. 1.40 m long, approx. 50 cm wide	958602	1
Sewing thread set, 32 colours, Thread and bobbing each 15 m long, 64 pieces	516743	1
Beech Dowel, approx \varnothing 15 x 500 mm	683038	2
Cotton Cord, natural, 160 m	537012	1
Recommended Tools		
Brother sewing machine RL417 or similar	621174	1
Household and Sewing Scissors	361233	1
Needle assortment 30 pieces	521382	1
Tape measure (1.5 m), printed on both sides	516709	1
Steel hardened pins, 20 g (0.65 x 30 mm)	521290	1



Cut the main fabric to the size of 57 x 50 cm.
Fold fabric with patterned sides together and press with iron.



Machine round the folded fabric.
Leave a margin of 1.5 cm and an opening at the top of approx. 12 - 15 cm
Machine with a zigzag stitch round the edges.
Turn the piece through the opening and hand sew the opening with a needle and thread.
Iron again.



Holder for the Beech Dowel:
Turn the top fabric over about 8 cm and machine sew (There should be a loop with about 4 cm for the rod). . Repeat this at the bottom of the fabric. Insert the dowels.



Attaching shaped pockets.

Cut the following pieces of fabric:

Droplet Fabric

- 1x approx. 16 cm Ø circle
- 2x approx. 16 x 16 cm heart
- 1x 22 x 21 cm approx

Graphic material:

- 1x 20 x 30 cm
- 1x 20 x 14 cm

Fold in half the rectangular fabrics, right sides together and tack round the edges

Allow a turning opening of approx. 4 cm.

Machine with a zigzag stitch round the edges.

Turn the piece through the opening and hand sew the opening with a needle and thread.

Fold the circle piece once to make semi circle, right sides together allow enough gap to turn through as above. Sew the opening with a needle and thread.

Do the same for the heart shapes.

Iron and press well.



Take all the shapes and place where required. secure with pins and tack.



Machine on the pockets with a lockstitch (remove wooden sticks beforehand) and, if necessary, divide the pockets with a seam.

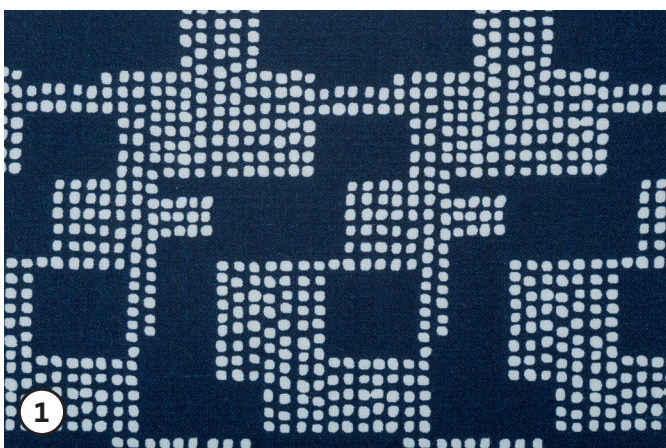


Thread in wooden sticks again and attach a cord at the top.

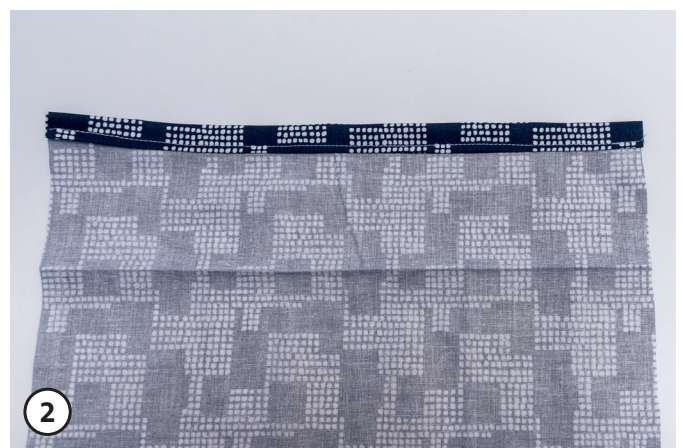
Heat Packs

Cotton fabric - Graphic, approx. 1.40 m long, approx. 50 cm wide	958602	1
Cotton fabric diamond pattern, approx. 1.40 m long, approx. 50 cm wide	958624	1
Cherry pips, about 500 g	520088	1
Cushion filling, approx. 200 x 150 mm, natural	418919	2
Sewing thread set, 32 colours, Thread and bobbing each 15 m long, 64 pieces	516743	1

Brother sewing machine RL417 or similar	621174	1
Household and Sewing Scissors	361233	1
Needle assortment 30 pieces	521382	1
Tape measure (1.5 m), printed on both sides	516709	1
Steel hardened pins, 20 g (0.65 x 30 mm)	521290	1



Cut fabric to the size of approx. 24 x 19 cm.



Turn over the upper sides once approx. 1 cm and sew over. Then turn again about 1 cm and stitch again.



Now cut in the fabric piece approx. 16 cm from the bottom and fold over the upper fabric piece. The fabrics should overlap approx. 4 cm, this is where the opening for the filling cushion is created.



Sew together the edges on the right and left and lap over. Fill filling pad with cherry stones and Close the filling seam.



Turn the pillow over and iron well. Put the heated cherry stone cushion in the cover.
