Sew Small Bags Yourself



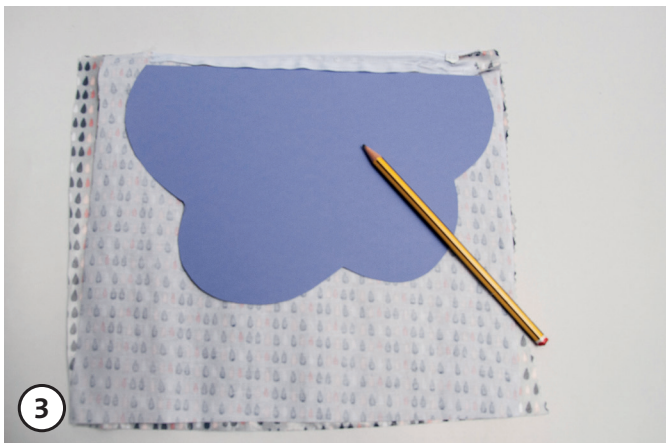

Zippers, approx. 200 x 25 mm, black, 10 pieces	516721	1
Cotton fabric drops, gray / colored, about 70 x 25 cm	958554	1
Cotton fabric plaid, mint / pink, approx. 70 x 25 cm	958543	1

Cotton fabric dots, white / black, about 70 x 25 cm	958532	1
Cotton fabric coated check, white / black, approx. 70 x 25 cm	958521	1
Sewing thread, 20 bobbins each 500 m, different colors, set of 20	729366	1

1
Choose the shape for the bag, print out the template and cut it out.



2
Cut the fabric to approx. 200 x 270 mm, attach the zipper from the left at the edge of the fabric. Tip: fix the zipper with pins, makes sewing easier.



3
Place the template on the fabric, align it with the zipper and draw with a pencil.



4
Cut out the shape from the fabric, with seam allowance of approx. 10 mm (cut both fabrics at the same time).

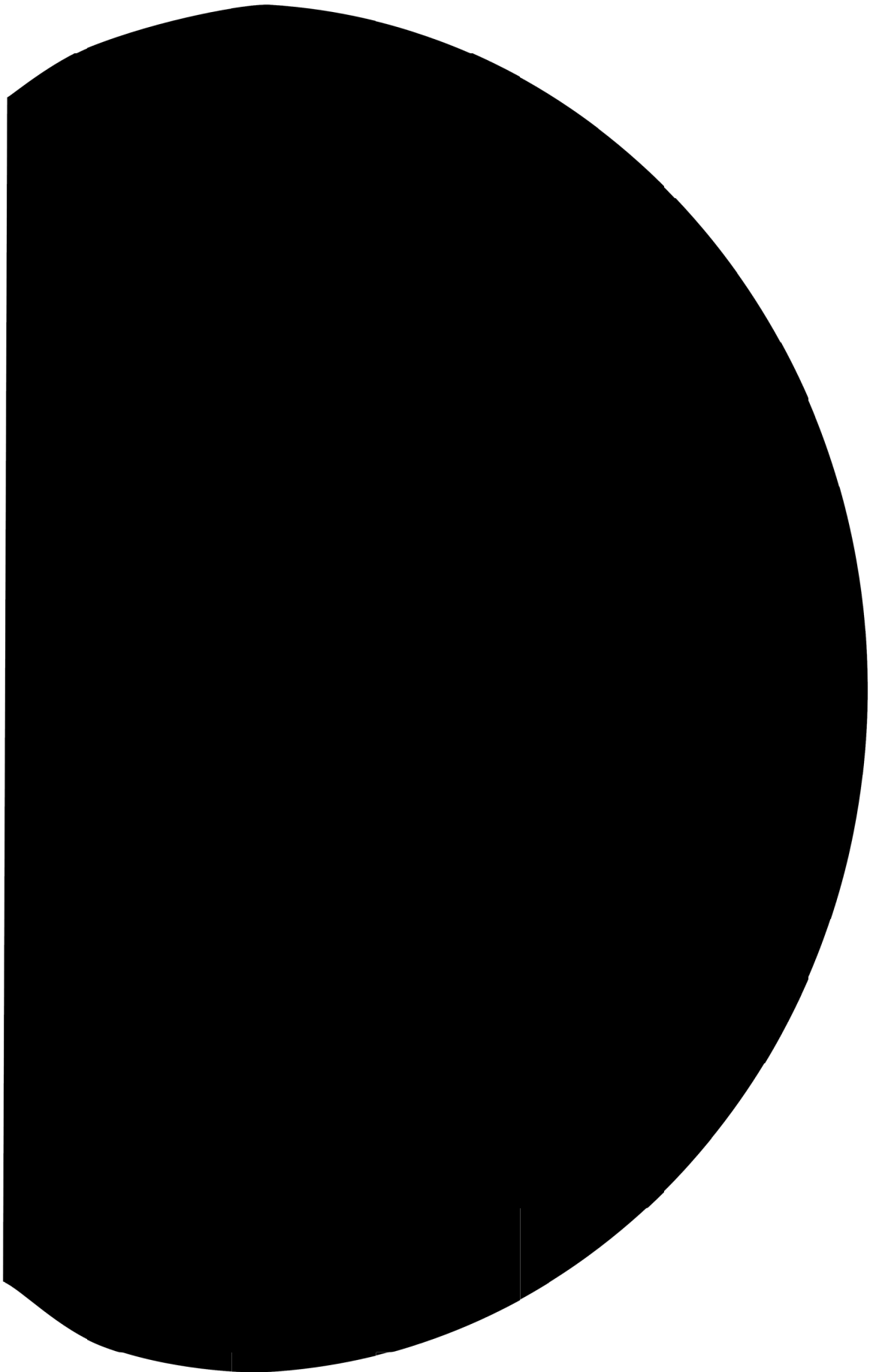


Sewn with a lockstitch and zigzag stitch from the left.
Note: Do not forget the ends of the zipper.



Now turn the bag through to the right side.
Note: For the cloud cosmetic bag, the curves
Carefully turn outward and snip.
