Tools Required		
Base, paper, pen, adhesive tape, baking paper, kitchen roll, water container, round and bristle brush, wooden sticks, pointy knife or scalpel, point embroidery needle, scissors, hand drill (or drill with wood drill)

- 1. Draw sketches on paper (seahorses, starfish, lifebuoy, fish, sailboat) with a pen...)
- 2. Cut out sketches.
- 3. Knead SIO-2 PLUS® hand-warm soft clay.

Roll out a soft-clay plate to about 5 mm thick.

- 5. Place sketches on soft-clay plate.
- 6. With a pointed knife, cus out the models.
- 7. Attention, do not forget to hang the hole (wooden sticks).
- 8. Soft-clay models can be decorated with Stoneplast Granite.
- 9. D. h. knead Stoneplast handwarm in advance and model it to the soft clay.
- 10. Alternatively, rinse out an approx. 5 mm thick Stoneplast plate.
- 11. Cut circles out of it with the cookie cutter.
- 12. Drill a hole in the middle of the circles for later threading.
- 13. If desired, press embossings into the modelled models with (modelling) woods.
- 14: Stoneplast granite balls in different sizes.
- 15. Make a hole in the center of the balls (embroidery needle / wooden sticks).
- 16. Lay all modeled accessories on baking paper, allow to air dry (about 1 3 days).
- 17. If desired, paint modeled accessories with Deco & Lifestyle craft paint.
- 18. Paint wood arrow as desired. Prime arrow first white. After drying, divide surfaces with adhesive tape. Paint them with other colours.
- 19. Allow the paint to dry.
- 20. Remove adhesive tape after drying.
- 21. Drill a hole in the middle of the pieces of wood and discs (hand drill).
- 22. Modeled accessories, (modeled and wood) beads, modeled discs, pieces of wood and discs thread with the string of beads.
- 23. If necessary, the individual accessories can also be fixed with craft glue.
- 24. Tie different strands to the wooden arrow.
- 25. Attach a keyring to loose strands.
- 26. A keychain could be attached here.
- 27. These loose key strands can also be hung on the arrow (key board).
- 28. Finally, shells can be fixed to the arrow and strands fixed using a hot glue gun.
