## Creative Set Bats



Material Used	Article Number	Quantity
Felt Plates, approx. 200 x 300 mm, grey	–	5
Cotton Fabric - Little Birds, approx. 50 x 70 cm	–	1
Sewing Thread black, 60 m long	–	1
Sewing Thread white, 60 m long	–	1
Cotton Wadding, 50 g	–	1
Pattern Chart	–	1
<b>Not included in the set</b>		
Sewing Needles, set of 60	516628	1
<b>Tools Required</b>		
Sewing Machine	621174	1
Scissors	361233	1

Content of the set is sufficient for 2 bats.



Transfer the pattern to the fabric using a seam allowance of approx. 0,5 cm, cut out and sew with backstitch.



The rectangles of the pattern will be the legs. Fold these along the center and sew the long sides together and a short side with backstitch. Turn the bat leg right side out through the open area.



Stitch the ears and cut the round parts a little with the scissors.



Turn the right side out and fill with wadding.



For the wings leave the straight side part open. Sew the rest, turn right side out and fill up.



Cut out both bodies from felt using approx. 1 cm seam allowance and turn right side out.



Use pins to attach ears and wings between the two felt layers for the bodies and sew. Don't sew the area for the legs.

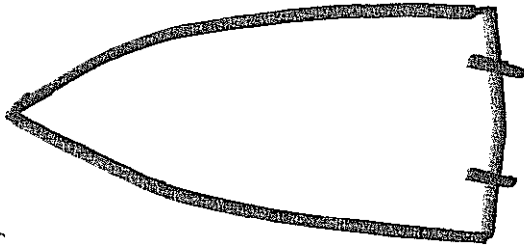
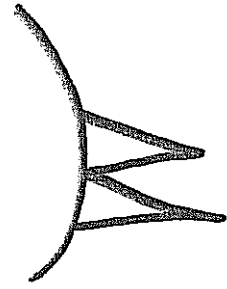
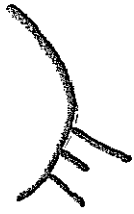


Also fix the legs with pins and sew from the right and from the left side leaving a central hole for the filling material. Fill in wadding and close with backstitch.



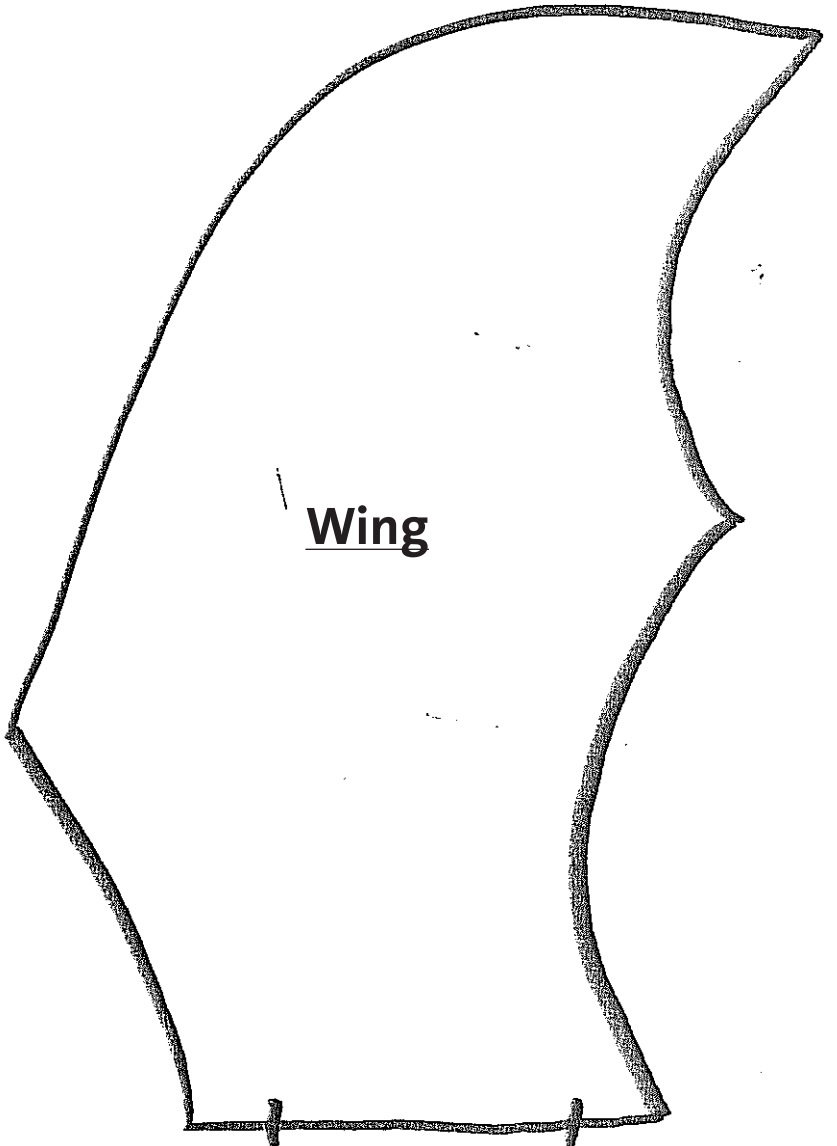
Make a loop at the feet and sew with a few stitches. Now the bat can dangle from a branch or wooden bar.

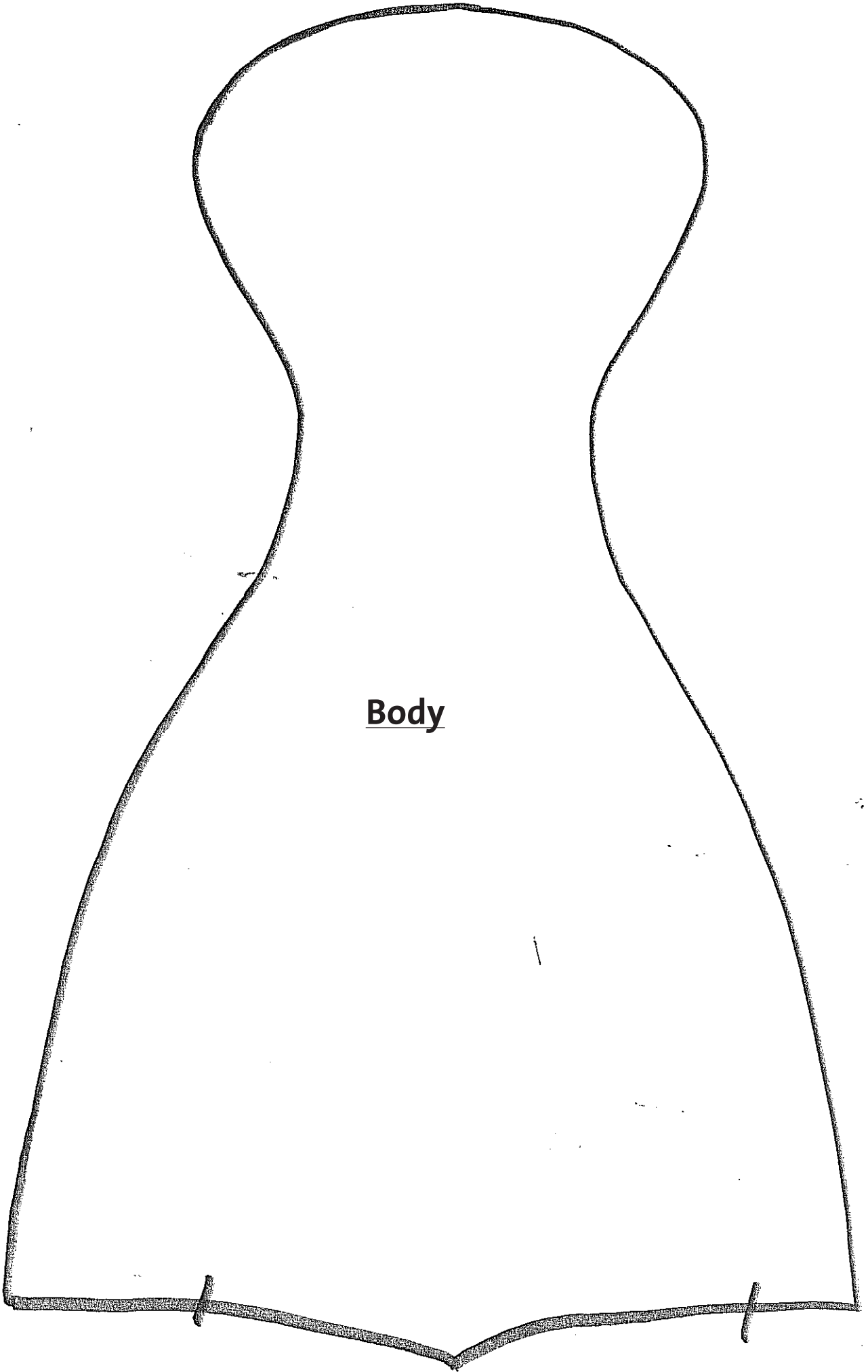


Ear
